On September 16, 2006, the Ojai Education Foundation sponsored its first annual signature fundraising event, "The Garden of Knowledge", a beautiful fall evening of gourmet food, art, music and literature in a bucolic Ojai setting. Dinner and entertainment took place



at the home of architect Marc Whitman. This event featured a silent auction of works by nationally known local artists, book signings by Ojai's own authors, a world-class jazz ensemble, and delectable cuisine based on seasonally fresh, local foods. A short program included presentation of the OEF Education Hero of the Year award, and a keynote presentation by Leslie Fausset. Fausset, a graduate of Nordhoff, served as Chief Deputy Superintendent of Public Instruction in the California Department of Education, and is now Superintendent of Solana Beach Unified School District. "I am honored to have been asked to come back to Ojai in this capacity, and am a firm believer in public education and the importance of community support for our public schools," said Fausset. EDUCATIONAL ENHANCEMENT

OEF provides support for District-wide activities that address specific educational needs not met with Federal, State or District funding. In 2006, our efforts focused on strengthening the District’s science programs by providing a science coordinator to train teachers and provide hands-on science demonstrations for OUSD elementary schools. In 2006 OEF funding provided partial salary support for Matilija Junior High School science teacher, Jim Bailey to serve as science coordinator (\$40,000).
